

Cadenhead's (distilled at Dailuaine) 1996

57.5%

Like being stuck inside the Dailuaine dark grains plant: all Marmite (yeast extract spread), deglazed roasting pan, and a cereal note. In other words, the distillery character is the major contributor. Some light nuttiness, but overall this is Dailuaine in funky guise. Becomes more, errr...*agricultural* with water.

Robust and peppery on the tongue. A nice example, albeit without massive complexity.

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
