

Kilkerran Work in Progress VII - Sherry

Distilled in 2004, this 11 year old sherry cask-matured expression from Glengyle in Campbeltown is one of two final releases under the Work in Progress banner. 6,000 bottles have been released.

Fragrant wood fires, fruity old leather, damp tweed, sherry, malt, and autumn berries on the nose.

The palate is oily, rich, and rounded, with zesty spice, then peaches in syrup and sweet smokiness. The spices persist. The finish is long and warming with chili, licorice, and worn leather.
